Course: LEOKA Officer Safety Awareness Training (OSAT): The mission of the FBI Law Enforcement Officers Killed and Assaulted (LEOKA) Program is to reduce incidents of law enforcement deaths and assaults. This class will include multiple case studies related to 20-years of FBI LEOKA research. The training topics will include: LEOKA introduction, statistics, accidental deaths, research, the Deadly Mix concept, street combat veterans (offender's perspective), and an officer involved shooting incident.

Instructor: Marcus Young is a Training Instructor for the FBI CJIS Division's Law LEOKA Program. Marcus is a military veteran and served 20-years in law enforcement. He earned a M.S. degree in Counseling Psychology and B.S. degree in Organizational Behavior from the University of San Francisco, CA. In 2004, President George W. Bush and California Governor Arnold Schwarzenegger awarded Marcus a Medal of Valor following an officer involved shooting incident.
