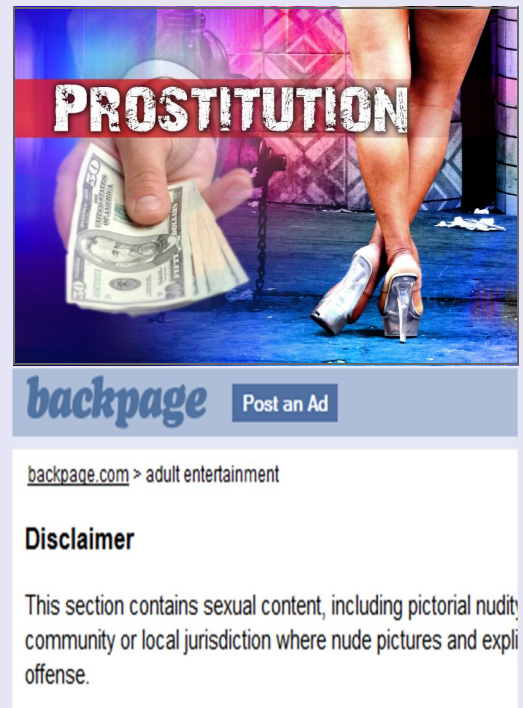

Riggi is dedicated to teaching the various investigative techniques for building prosecutable vice cases and keeping the agents who work these unique crimes safe and aware of the pitfalls that they may encounter.
